Council Tax 2017 to 2018

SPENDING ON OUR SERVICES

This financial year, 2017 to 2018, we are planning to spend £1,482.3 million, an increase of £11.7 million, from last year's budget.

Government grants make up 82% (£1,215.8 million) and Council Tax 18% (£266.5 million) of our total planned net expenditure. This represents a Band D Council Tax charge of £1,249 for 2017/18, an increase of 3% to the 2016/17 Band D Council Tax charge of £1213.

The band D Council Tax rate in 2017 to 2018 is £1,249. The Scottish average in 2016 to 2017 was £1,149.

Our planned spend is 1.38% above the Scottish Government support figure. The expenditure figure used by the Government in the "Aggregate External Finance" (Government Support) calculation is £5,710 for each band D property and this compares to £5,789 proposed spending by the council.
