## Glasgow City Council's Statutory Performance Information 2016/17

## Background

Glasgow City Council reports every year on a set of performance indicators known as the Statutory Performance Information or SPIs.

These indicators form part of the Local Government Benchmarking Framework (LGBF). The indicators included in the SPIs fall into these categories:

- Corporate Services
- Culture and Leisure Services
- Corporate Assets
- Environmental Services

This data is compiled in the council and is verified for accuracy by the council's internal audit team.

## Our performance

The table below shows the council's performance for 2016/17 on these indicators. It shows performance for the previous three years in most instances, the preferred trend and whether performance has improved. When comparing this year's performance with last year's, 7 indicators (78\%) showed improvement but 2 (22\%) showed a decline in performance.

As in 2015/16 the council is required to report on the gender pay gap between the average hourly rate of pay for male and female employees. In 2016/17 the average hourly rate for men is $£ 15.74$ and that for women is $£ 16.84$ resulting in a gender pay gap of $-7.0 \%$.
