I was delighted that after nearly four years that the bridge on Balmore Road and Broadholm Street will be put right.





Councillor Gary Gray, Paul Sweeney MP and I have been making complaints to Scottish Water and Network Rail. I am very pleased that Scottish Water have taken responsibility for the repairs. Scottish Water are planning to start the work in January 2019 and estimate the duration of the works will be six months.

I would also like to thank local residents for bringing this to our attention and for your patience in trying to get this serious matter resolved.

It's a real victory for the community, just a pity it took so long.

Play Park - ARC, Ashgill Road, Milton



I would like to thank the Ashgill Resource Centre Steering Group for the hard work and resilience they have shown regarding the above play park. The Steering Group and local people in the area have been trying to secure a play park for the local community for seven years now. There has been ongoing issues with the ground and whether it was suitable to sustain a play park.

I am pleased to say that we have now had confirmation from the Council that the land can indeed support a park. However, due to the state of the land it will need some remedial work which will add to the cost.

The Steering Group said that this is the furthest that they have managed to get with the project in seven years. The real hard work starts now, the Steering Group are in the process of conducting a survey in the area. This is something that possible funders will require before they will part with their money. The consultation will take approximately three months.

The Steering Group along with GCC Officers and myself have come up with the names of funding streams that they might look to apply to for funding after the consultation is completed.

I am very pleased to be involved with this project. The young people of Milton and their parents deserve a proper modern play park.

Try Something New

It was with great pleasure that I met with Try Something New a group of disabled young people who are based in Possobilities in Possilpark.

The group have recognised the hardship faced by homeless people over the winter period, especially those with mental health problems, and they have started a campaign to raise awareness of the problem. They are also hoping to collect scarves, hats and gloves to donate to the homeless over the winter. Councillor Gary Gray and I are hoping to help wherever we can with this project.
