





Dear colleagues,

I am writing to support the proposed traffic regulation order:

**THE GLASGOW CITY COUNCIL
(IBROX STADIUM)

It is my view, after listening to a range of views in the areas of my ward that would be affected by this Order, and after engaging with Council officers, that on balance the scheme will deliver improvements which are to the benefit of residents as well as encouraging modal shift towards more sustainable transport options, which must continue to be a cornerstone of this city's transport and neighbourhoods strategies going forward. The current existing arrangements are both ineffective and inefficient and there must be improvement via this Order.

I note some concerns from residents around the potential for abuse of the permitting system. It is my strong view that policy/procedure should be introduced by the department, alongside the Order, which sets out how the department will monitor potential abuse and take appropriate action if it suspects abuse is taking place. The intent of the Order is clear in that it is to alleviate the pressure on parking in areas surrounding Ibrox stadium, and as such, that should be reinforced through policies and procedures. The suggestion I have discussed with officers is a 'trigger point' – suggested at 20 permits – above which applications will require documentary evidence of need, which must stand up to basic scrutiny in order to prevent abuse. Obvious points of reference include the trading hours of premises, and also their permitted capacity for licence conditions etc. I would welcome further clarification from Officers on these points.

I also note some concerns from residents about enforcement. I am reassured that the Order will make it easier to enact enforcement effectively. However it is essential that enhanced enforcement is carried out in the 'bedding in' phase for the Order and that officers continue to seek to improve the effective use of the ongoing enforcement resource that is available, by deploying more agile working methods and through intelligence sharing with the local community. I cannot stress this enough as an area for priority focus.

I also note the objections of many football supporters, many of whom do not live locally. I would ask that these are naturally given a lower weighting to the views of local residents in assessing the merits of the Order. I further urge the Club, supporters groups, transport operators and local transport partners to work together to improve the provision of sustainable transport options which can improve the match day experience for everyone concerned.

I look forward to the successful introduction of this Order.

I am a resident at number [REDACTED] and would like to note my support for the implementation of the Event Day Zone Parking scheme in this area.

Living on a corner plot, our driveway is frequently blocked by inconsiderate parking during football matches at Ibrox Park. This results in my wife and me being unable to either leave or return to our driveway during these events. As a consequence, we have often been late or unable to collect our children from various clubs on a Saturday afternoon or Wednesday evening. On one occasion, our 13 year old son was left on his own outside a sports club on a cold, dark winter evening as we could not collect him due to being blocked in our driveway. Being unable to enter our driveway also means that we are given no other option but to park illegally on the street. As [REDACTED], my wife has to have access to and from our driveway throughout the day and evening. Fortunately, she has not been prevented from attending a call through inappropriate parking on match days, but there is no guarantee this will be the case in the future.

[REDACTED] is a quiet residential area in which our young children have enjoyed growing up. However, we were never able to let our children walk to a neighbours house during match day events due the volume of cars speeding through the narrow [REDACTED] streets, often on the wrong side of the road. It is only through

restricting their freedom during match days that we have avoided an inevitable accident. The dimension of the roads in [REDACTED] meant they were never intended for the volume of traffic that is received during match days. This is not only dangerous for pedestrians but for other motorists trying to manoeuvre out of the area.

The volume of traffic and difficulty parking has meant we can no longer ask friends and family to come to our house on a Saturday. All too often our children have not been able to be collected or dropped off from various events as other parents are understandably hesitant about driving and attempting to park in [REDACTED] during a match.

For these reasons in particular, I strongly support the parking controls for match day events. This will provide the opportunity for me and my family to live a life free from the stress and anxiety which is a result of match day parking.

I can confirm that, if this scheme is implemented, enforcement will be carried out by my enforcement team. I am aware of the existing problems of parking in the area and have requested for some targeted enforcement to be carried out. Furthermore, it has been noted that some missing yellow lining requires reinstatement and have requested that this be carried out to assist with enforcement.

I can advise that introducing additional controls on permit applications or restricting permits to a specific area was not part of the original proposals that were publicised and I am unable to consider any more stringent amendments at this time in the statutory process. The permit facility should allow the local community to operate like on non-event days, therefore local organisations and businesses can apply for permits free of charge. It would not be expected for local residents to abuse the permit system to negatively affect the local community, however any misuse can be reported to the Council for investigation.

All applications for permits will be decided and monitored by the Council's Customer and Business Services team, any unusual activity or irregularities will be reported for an investigation to be carried out. I am writing to give my support to the new parking regulations that are proposed to be introduced by Glasgow City Council and will improve the lives of local residents. The existing situation makes life very difficult on match days for residents. The comments I have are

1. I fully support the introduction of the scheme and especially the extension to the original plan to cover the entire [REDACTED] area.
2. I am concerned that insufficient resources will be allocated in enforcing the scheme, diluting the effect of the controls. Existing traffic regulations being regularly breached (parking on double yellow lines, bus stops, on pavements and firepaths) and would like to hope that in the initial period of the controls being implemented there would be a zero tolerance approach to make sure the message gets through that the new controls are in effect.
3. Controls on the issues of Parking permits to Businesses , such that local businesses cannot in effect make a business out of supplying parking permits in return for payment.
4. Looking at methods of introducing controls on the issues of permits to residents to make it more difficult to give away or sell resident or visitor permits to non residents. Could a permit have a list of vehicle registration numbers that it is valid for and could there be a maximum number of visitor or resident permits a local resident can buy. Will a permit be only valid in a specific area or will all permits be valid throughout the entire Ibrox Event Control area The documentation does not really detail how the permits will be controlled.
5. Could the scheme be extended to cover other large events in Bellahouston Park. E.g. Bubble Rush, Dog Jog, Fun run and the Boyne Parade. Summer Sessions already has its own parking controls on the days of concerts



On 19th May I received a newsletter from our community council instructing me to register immediate support for the proposed parking scheme debarring football supporters from our area. However I am not in favour of the scheme as I would much prefer that the present arrangement remains in force with the proviso that the area be supervised at appropriate times.

I feel the proposals would penalise the vast majority of drivers who do nothing wrong and also that the blanket ban would include areas - such as east of Bellahouston Academy - where there are no residential properties.

It seems however that supervision is a forlorn hope and it would appear that implementation of the scheme is now a formality judging by the community council newsletter of spring 2018 which indicates your revised Schedule includes within June 2018 "Advise all objectors that the Order has been made despite objections".

Nevertheless I wish to make several points - see separate pages

My main reason for writing is to ask that you will humour me by providing some information relative to family visits by the old fashioned means of letter or telephone viz

My wife has been in care homes for several years and family members who live outwith Glasgow visit me when they go to her present care home. Despite there having been no supervisory staff on duty when supporters arrived in recent times it seems

that sufficient will become available to man check points and prevent footfall supporters acting no go men. I should like to know where check points will be located and whether my family will be allowed to pass through when they are shooting.
How will it be known that nobody would sneak off to Libya?

[REDACTED] has unfortunately had exceptional traffic and parking problems re [REDACTED]

Traffic has been a bugbear for at least 10 years - There have been numerous occasions when construction work at the local school and use of their grounds for all sorts of reasons have caused much disruption - The area has borne more than a fair share of further disruption, and restrictions, over the years due to races and pop concerts - and recently due to the apparent lack of parking provision for construction workers at the Bellahouston Park hospice they have had to use our roads.

It seems that so many problems for so long has resulted in many locals being keen to have football related traffic removed (despite football supporters not being responsible for any of the above)

Specifics relative to Community Council Views.

(1) While recently visiting my wife's care home on four match days I travelled through [REDACTED] and was pleasantly surprised by just how few badly parked cars there were. On one occasion there were three cars illegally parked further down my own road - but I suspect these related to a local. I did see a car parked at the junction of [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] but this is a wide angled corner with a straight section of approx 15 feet and, with no parking allowed on the opposite sides of these roads, it did not prove much of an obstruction. (Construction site parking and school kick up parking have often been very much worse) I am fairly sure two photographs of this corner on a match day appear on the local spring newsletter.

(2) The statement in the current newsletter that there is ample public transport to the stadium beggars belief. Many who

park in our area come from outside the city. For example I recently spoke to a driver from 'new Aberdeen' and a small group from 'near Musselburgh' who would have extreme difficulty in using public transport to reach Glasgow and huge problems returning after an evening match.

Fifty years ago I travelled from [REDACTED] by public transport. It was difficult enough then and worse now. In addition other potential passengers would be unable to board buses already full of football supporters.

Public transport is not geared to dealing with the numbers who attend Ibrox at roughly the same time.

Further Points

Following trial and error over a lengthy period the present system of parking on one side of most roads was introduced. This worked well but problems arose due to difficulties in establishing the relationship between Glasgow City Council and Police Scotland with regard to parking violations (For a while there had been a strict enforcement policy.) Unfortunately Police Scotland now appear to be much overstretched and seem to be unable and/or unwilling to provide officers (We have not seen a community type uniformed officer in our area for approx 15 years.)

- - -
Residents at the lower end of [REDACTED] have no real problem with football supporters, most of whom arrive early. Some remain in their cars before making for the match.

Other parts of [REDACTED] apparently do have difficulties - but these could be dealt with if a police officer could be spared.


The impact of a free for all parking in my street on event and football match day's is unacceptable.

No car should be parked after our drive as we are directly in front of the traffic lights at the crossroads of [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] but individuals desperate for a parking space on match day's, happily move the cones and park almost on the lights, at present there is no policing of this blatant flouting of the coning system.

A further intrusion is that when no more spaces are available on the road, cars then mount the pavement outside our home, blocking pedestrian access and loading access to our premises.

I've watched Ambulances mount the pavement in order to travel for emergency purposes, completely unacceptable.
