Notice is hereby given under Regulation 9 of the Local Authority Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2014, reflecting amendments in the Coronavirus (Scotland) Act 2020 that:

- a) Copies of the unaudited accounts of, GLASGOW CITY COUNCIL, WEST OF SCOTLAND ARCHAEOLOGY SERVICE and WEST OF SCOTLAND EUROPEAN FORUM for the period from 1 April 2019 to 31 March 2020 will be available for public inspection from 19 August 2020 to 8 September 2020, both days inclusive. Public inspection will not be available at our offices as a result of our response to the coronavirus pandemic. If information cannot be made available, either electronically or in hard copy, council officers will make contact to provide access when there is no longer a significant risk of the transmission of coronavirus. - b) Any person interested may inspect a copy of the abstracts of the accounts to be audited, all books, deeds, contracts, bills, vouchers and receipts related thereto, and may take copies of any or all parts of the accounts without charge in line with the arrangements outlined above;
- c) Any person interested may object to the accounts or to any part of those accounts, as follows:
 - i) in respect of Glasgow City Council any objection must be sent in writing stating the grounds for the objection to the auditor John Cornett, Audit Director, Audit Scotland via email to JCornett@audit-scotland.gov.uk not later than 9 September 2020, and to the authority and to any officer of the authority who may be concerned, via email to Martin.Booth@glasgow.gov.uk;
 - ii) in respect of West of Scotland Archaeology Service and West of Scotland European Forum any objection must be sent in writing stating the grounds for the objection to the auditor Stephen O'Hagan, Senior Audit Manager, Audit Scotland via email to SOhagan@audit-scotland.gov.uk not later than 9 September 2020, and to the authority and to any officer of the authority who may be concerned via email to Martin.Booth@glasgow.gov.uk;
- d) The auditor shall, if requested by the person objecting, the authority, or by any officer of the authority who may be concerned, afford to that person or authority or officer, as the case may be, an opportunity of appearing before and being heard by the auditor with respect to that objection; and any such person or officer may so appear and be heard either personally or by a representative. It should be noted that this may be delivered virtually or by telephone given current restrictions.
