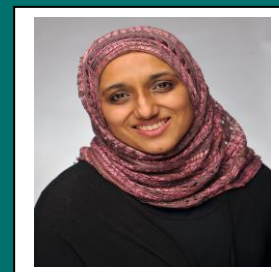

I share concerns about the impact of cuts to local services. I have previously contacted the chief executive of the council and the City Convenor for Sustainability & Carbon Reduction to request improvements to cleansing services in the ward - including the Govanhill neighbourhood.

Local Communities Want a Clean and Green Area

There have been complaints regarding cleansing services, infestations and lack of adequate bins. I raised the lack of bins in the Govanhill neighbourhood with the department of Neighbourhoods, Regeneration and Sustainability. I am pleased that small tin bins have been replaced with green general waste bins in the Govanhill neighbourhood. I have arranged various site visits and raised community aspirations for environmental back court and lane improvement. However, issues with missed bin collections, education and enforcement persist. I will continue to campaign for additional resources - the local community want a clean and green area.



Walkabout with Myrtleshaw Residents



I arranged a walkabout with Myrtleshaw Residents, Glasgow City Council and Glasgow Housing Association to address environmental concerns.

Cleansing, grass cutting, infestation and fly-tipping issues were raised.

New Nursery and MUGA in Cuthbertson Primary School

I am delighted to have supported Cuthbertson Parent Council and the local community in their aspirations for a new nursery and multi-use games area for their school. Victoria nursery is due to be completed in early summer 2022.

Cuthbertson Primary playground resurfacing will be completed in 3 phases. The first phase took place during the 2021 summer break, phase 2 will be over easter 2022 and the MUGA will be completed in summer 2022. I look forward to children and families benefiting from enhanced learning and play space.
