I will now declare the result of the election in the Ward 5 Govan. There are 4 Councillors to be elected.
The electorate was 20,026 and the number of ballot papers received was 6,689 giving a percentage turnout of $33.4 \%$. There were 233 rejected ballot papers. The quota of votes for a candidate to be elected was 1,292 .
