I will now declare the result of the election in the Ward 3 Greater Pollok. There are 4 Councillors to be elected.

The electorate was 25,241 and the number of ballot papers received was 9,138 giving a percentage turnout of 36.2%. There were 269 rejected ballot papers. The quota of votes for a candidate to be elected was 1,774.
