I will now declare the result of the election in the Ward 9 Calton. There are 4 Councillors to be elected.
The electorate was 19,673 and the number of ballot papers received was 6,274 giving a percentage turnout of $31.9 \%$. There were 202 rejected ballot papers. The quota of votes for a candidate to be elected was 1,215 .
