Pollok Stables Refurbishment

Progress So Far

As you will see when you pass you will see the site is now under construction and the careful dismantling of the building is now well underway. Contractors City Property and Reigart have taken down the majority of roof/building areas in poor condition, working with structural engineers Narro Associates, and other specialists with expertise in slate, timber, stone, along with a Conservation Architect.

GCC will work with City Property and Reigart to ensure that the building is secure and water-tight before reconstruction. The building is in process of being safely retained and scaffolding has now been erected.

Page\Park have been appointed as the architects for the project and have been working on an initial design brief with various stakeholders and potential users.

Have a look at the picture below to see what else we have been up to during this time.

The stones have been taken down carefully and each stone has been palletted and numbered to ensure that existing materials can be re-used during the rebuild phase.
