# The Glasgow City Council (Red/Broomfield/Balornock/Wallacewell/Northgate Roads) (Traffic Regulation) Order 2024

Glasgow City Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Police Scotland hereby make the following Order:-

#### **Citation and Commencement**

This Order may be cited as "The Glasgow City Council (Red/Broomfield/Balornock/Wallacewell/Northgate Roads) (Traffic Regulation) Order 2024" and shall come into operation on 03 June 2024

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies to an Act of Parliament.

Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactment.

#### **Definitions**

In this Order the following expressions have the meanings hereby assigned to them:-

- "Balornock (Service) Road" refers to the road running parallel on the east/ south side of Balornock Road between Broomfield Road and at a point 56 meters east of the east kerbline of Menzies Road
- "Chief Constable" means the Chief Constable of Police Scotland;
- "Council" means Glasgow City Council;
- "Cycle Lane" has the same meaning as in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016:
- "Emergency services vehicle" means a vehicle being used by Police, Fire Brigade, Ambulance Services or Civil Defence Organisations;
- "Emergency services purpose" means the saving of life or extinguishing fire or meeting any other like emergency;
- "Wallacewell (Northern Service) Road" refers to the road running parallel on the north side of Wallacewell Road between Broomfield Road and Northgate Road
- "Pedal Cycle" means a unicycle, bicycle, tricycle or cycle having 4 or more wheels, not being in any way mechanically propelled unless it is an electrically assisted pedal cycle of such class as to be treated as not being a motor vehicle for the purposes of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

"Penalty Charge Notice" means a device containing the information required by the Road Traffic Act 1991 for a penalty charge:

"Wallacewell (Southern Service) Road" refers to the road running parallel on the south side of Wallacewell Road between Broomfield Road and Standburn Road;

"Un-named Road 1" refers to the length of road from Balornock Road to the north of the Stobhill Hospital grounds;

"Vehicle" unless the context otherwise requires, means a vehicle of any description and includes a machine or implement of any kind drawn or propelled along roads whether by animal or mechanical power;

"Wallacewell Road" refers to the primary road between Broomfield Road and Standburn Road. It does not refer to the Northern or Southern Service Road.

#### Format of the Order

In the following Schedules of this Order there are Articles pertaining to each particular Schedule outlining the restrictions, permissions and conditions relevant to each particular Schedule. Each Schedule shall precede the Articles pertaining to that Schedule.

#### Schedule 1

#### No waiting at any time/ No loading or unloading at any time

#### **Red Road**

- 1. On east side from the extended south kerbline of Petershill Drive, northwards for a distance of 376 meters to the extended south kerbline of Broomfield Road
- 2. On west side from the extended south kerbline of Barmulloch Road, southwards for a distance of 26 meters

#### **Broomfield Road**

- 1. On north side from a point 25 meters west of the extended west kerbline of Balornock Road, westwards for a distance of 21 meters
- 2. On south side from the extended east kerbline of Red Road, eastwards for a distance of 52 meters
- 3. On north side from a point 54 meters east of the extended east kerbline of Red Road, westwards then northwards for a distance of 813 meters to a point 16m south of the extended north kerbline of Broomfield Road (kerbline adjacent to park)
- 4. On south side from the extended north kerbline of Barmulloch Road, westwards for a distance of 30 meters

#### **Balornock Road**

- On east side from a point 70 meters north of the extended north kerbline of Broomfield Road (kerbline adjacent to park), northwards for a distance of 178 meters to a point 17 meters south of the extended south kerbline of Un-named Road 1
- On west side from a point 20 meters north of the extended north kerbline of Broomfield Road (kerbline adjacent to park) for a distance of 216 meters to a point 30 meters south of the extended south kerbline of Un-named Road 1

#### Wallacewell Road (not either of the parallel service roads)

 On both sides from the extended east kerbline of Broomfield Road, eastwards then northwards to a point 13 meters west of the extended west kerbline of Standburn Road

#### Wallacewell (Northern Service) Road

1. On both sides from a point 11 meters west of the extended west kerbline of Northgate Road, westwards for a distance of 20 meters

2. On both sides from a point 20 meters east of the extended east kerbline of Northgate Road, eastwards for a distance of 19 meters

#### **Northgate Road**

- On east side from the extended south kerbline of Auchinairn Road, southwards for a distance of 57 meters
- 2. On west side from a point 17 meters south of the extended south kerbline of Auchinairn Road, southwards for a distance of 22 meters
- 3. On east side from a point 10 meters north of the extended north kerbline of Broomton Road, southwards to a point 8 meters south of the extended south kerbline of Broomton Road
- On east side from a point 18 meters north of the extended north kerbline of Geddes Road, southwards to a point 17 meters south of the extended south kerbline of Geddes Road
- 5. On west side from a point 261 meters south of the extended south kerbline of Auchinairn Road, southwards for a distance of 24 meters to a point 380 meters north of the extended north kerbline of Wallacewell Road
- 6. On east side from a point 10 meters north of the extended north kerbline of Ferness Place, southwards to a point 9 meters south of the extended south kerbline of Ferness Place
- 7. On west side from a point 414 meters south of the extended south kerbline of Auchinairn Road, southwards for a distance of 25 meters to a point 225 meters north of the extended north kerbline of Wallacewell Road
- 8. On west side from a point 504 meters south of the extended south kerbline of Auchinairn Road, southwards for a distance of 25 meters to a point 137 meters north of the extended north kerbline of Wallacewell Road
- On east side from a point 10 meters south of the extended south kerbline of Ferness Road, northwards to a point 9 meters north of the extended north kerbline of Ferness Road
- 10. On west side from extended north kerbline of Wallacewell Road, northwards for a distance of 24m
- 11. On east side from extended north kerbline of Wallacewell Road, northwards for a distance of 26m

#### **Petershill Drive**

- On both sides from a point 231 meters north of the extended south kerbline of Dykemuir Street, eastwards for a distance of 10 meters
- 2. On north side from a point 98 meters south of the extended south kerbline of Dykemuir Street, eastwards for a distance of 18 meters

#### **Red Road Court**

 On both sides from the extended east kerbline of Red Road, eastwards for a distance of 10 meters

#### **Barmulloch Road**

 On both sides from the extended east kerbline of Red Road, westwards for a distance of 26 meters

#### **Wallacewell Quadrant**

- On both sides from the extended south kerbline of Wallacewell Road at a point 48
  meters east of the extended east kerbline of Lamont Road, southwards for a distance
  of 10 meters
- On both sides from the extended south kerbline of Wallacewell Road at a point 215 meters east of the extended east kerbline of Lamont Road, southwards for a distance of 10 meters

#### **Acredyke Road**

- On south side from the extended west kerbline of Northgate Road at a point 17
  meters south of the extended south kerbline of Auchinairn Road, westwards for a
  distance of 10 meters
- On both sides from the extended west kerbline of Northgate Road at a point 124
  meters north of the extended north kerbline of Wallacewell Road, westwards for a
  distance of 10 meters

#### **Ferness Road**

 On both sides from the extended east kerbline of Northgate Road, eastwards for a distance of 10 meters

#### **Northgate Quadrant**

- On both sides from the extended west kerbline of Northgate Road at a point 235
  meters north of the extended north kerbline of Wallacewell Road, westwards for a
  distance of 10 meters
- On both sides from the extended west kerbline of Northgate Road at a point 389
  meters north of the extended north kerbline of Wallacewell Road, westwards for a
  distance of 10 meters

#### **Ferness Place**

 On both sides from the extended east kerbline of Northgate Road, eastwards for a distance of 10 meters

#### **Geddes Road**

1. On both sides from the extended east kerbline of Northgate Road, eastwards for a distance of 25 meters

#### **Broomton Road**

1. On both sides from the extended east kerbline of Northgate Road, eastwards for a distance of 10 meters

#### **Articles Pertaining to Schedule 1**

### No Waiting at any time No Loading or Unloading at any time

#### **Waiting restrictions**

1. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1.

#### Loading or unloading restrictions

 No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to load or unload at any time in the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1.

#### **Exemptions from waiting and loading or unloading restrictions**

- 3. Nothing in Articles 1 and 2 hereof shall:-
  - (i) prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait, load or unload in the lengths of roads referred to in this Article:
    - a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle or to load or unload his or her personal luggage;
    - b) if the vehicle is an emergency services vehicle being used for emergency services purposes:
    - c) if the vehicle is prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond the driver's control or which has to be stopped in order to avoid injury or damage to persons or property;
    - d) if the vehicle is a marked vehicle which, whilst used by a universal postal service provider in the course of the provision of a universal postal service, is stationary only for the delivery or collection of postal packets;
  - (ii) apply to a pedal cycle attached to a stand which displays the sign corresponding to The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 diagram number 968 or 968.1;
  - (iii) apply to a vehicle left in a parking space designated in Schedules 3 to 7, 10 and 11 in accordance with the Articles pertaining thereto.

#### **Penalty Charge**

- 4. (i) A penalty charge, as permitted by the Road Traffic Act 1991, as amended, shall be payable, with respect to a vehicle, if that vehicle is waiting, loading or unloading on any length of road specified in Schedule 1 otherwise than in accordance with the provisions of Articles 1 to 3 hereof.
  - (ii) The penalty charge shall be £60, discounted to £30 if paid within 14 days and £90 if unpaid after 56 days, as amended from time to time.
  - (iii) A penalty charge notice shall be attached to the vehicle, or handed to the owner or person who appears to be in charge of the vehicle, incurring the penalty charge.
- 4. Where a penalty charge notice has been attached to a vehicle in accordance with Article 4 (iii) hereof, no person, other than the owner or person who appears to be in charge of the vehicle or a person duly authorised by the Council, shall remove the penalty charge notice from the vehicle unless authorised to do so by the owner or person who appears to be in charge of the vehicle. Any person who removes a penalty charge notice without the proper authority shall be guilty of an offence in terms of Section 66(6) of the Road Traffic Act 1991 as amended.
- 5. If a penalty charge notice has been issued in accordance with Article 4 hereof, a parking attendant may remove the vehicle or cause the vehicle to be removed. If it is removed the Council shall provide for the safe custody of the vehicle.

#### Power to dispose of abandoned vehicles

6. Subject to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the Council may, as respects a vehicle which has been removed in pursuance with Article 6 hereof, sell or otherwise dispose of the vehicle if it appears to have been abandoned, provided they have made reasonable enquiry to ascertain the name and address of the owner of the vehicle and to inform the owner of their intention.

#### Schedule 2

#### Prohibition of driving in a mandatory Cycle Lane

#### **Red Road**

On east side from extended north kerbline of Petershill Drive at point 98 meters south
of the extended south kerbline of Dykemuir Street, northwards for a distance of 358
meters to a point 18 meters south of the extended south kerbline of Broomfield Road

#### **Broomfield Road**

 On north side from a point 54 meters east of the extended east kerbline of Red Road, westwards then northwards for a distance of 826 meters to the extended north kerbline of Broomfield Road (kerbline adjacent to park)

#### **Balornock Road**

- On east side from the extended north kerbline of Broomfield Road (kerbline adjacent to park), northwards for a distance of 249 meters to a point 17 meters south of the extended south kerbline of Un-named Road 1
- On west side from a point 120 meters north of the extended north kerbline of Broomfield Road (kerbline adjacent to park) for a distance of 130 meters to a point 17 meters south of the extended south kerbline of Un-named Road 1

#### Wallacewell Road (not either of the parallel service roads)

- 1. On north side from the extended east kerbline of Broomfield Road, westwards to a point 13 meters west of the extended west kerbline of Standburn Road
- 2. On south side from the extended east kerbline of Broomfield Road, westwards to a point 21 meters west of the extended west kerbline of Standburn Road

#### **Northgate Road**

- On east side from a point 16 meters south of the extended south kerbline of Auchinairn Road, southwards to the extended north kerbline of Wallacewell Road
- 2. On west side from a point 32 meters south of the extended south kerbline of Auchinairn Road, southwards to the extended north kerbline of Wallacewell Road

#### **Articles Pertaining to Schedule 2**

#### **Prohibition of driving in a mandatory Cycle Lane**

#### Prohibition of Being in a mandatory Cycle Lane

1. No person shall drive or cause or permit any vehicle to be driven in a Cycle Lane, except upon the direction of / or with permission of a Police Constable in uniform, on any of the lengths of roads listed in Schedule 2 other than a pedal cycle where the Cycle Lane is segregated from the main carriageway by a white line or physical barrier and signed in accordance with The Traffic Signs and Regulations 2016.

#### **Exemptions from Prohibition of Being in a mandatory Cycle Lane**

Nothing in Article 1 hereof shall apply if the vehicle is

- i) An emergency services vehicle being used for emergency services purpose
- ii) To be used in connection with any building or roadworks operations or works associated with the provision or maintenance of public utilities, provided that prior permission has been granted by the Council, including works being done by the Council or on the Councils behalf.
- iii) Crossing the cycle lane in order to gain access to or egress from a vehicular access point or loading area or parking area adjacent to or accessible only by crossing the cycle lane.

#### Schedule 3

#### Prohibition of vehicles except pedal cycles

#### Wallacewell (Northern Service) Road

- From the extended west kerbline of Northgate Road, westwards for a distance of 11 meters
- 2. From the extended east kerbline of Northgate Road, eastwards for a distance of 20 meters

#### **Balornock (Service) Road**

 Between the extended east kerbline of Broomfield Road and extended west kerbline of Balornock (Service Road), from a point 5 meters south of the extended south building line of Number 2 Balornock Road, southwards for a distance of 13 meters

#### **Articles Pertaining to Schedule 3**

#### Prohibition of vehicles except pedal cycles

#### **Prohibition of vehicles restriction**

1. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to be driven on any of the lengths of roads listed in Schedule 3.

#### **Exemptions from Prohibition of vehicles restriction**

- 2. Nothing in Article 1 hereof shall apply if the vehicle is:-
  - (i) an emergency services vehicle being used for emergency services purposes.
  - (ii) to be used in connection with any building or roadworks operations, or works associated with the provision or maintenance of public utilities, provided that prior permission has been granted by the Council, including works being done by the Council or on the Council's behalf.
  - (iii) A vehicle in connection with a relevant event, which has been given permission to be there by Glasgow City Council.
  - (iv) a pedal cycle.

#### **Penalty Charge**

3.

- (i) A penalty charge, as permitted by the Road Traffic Act 1991, as amended, shall be payable, with respect to a vehicle, if that vehicle is waiting in the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 3 otherwise than in accordance with the provisions of Articles 2 and 4 hereof.
- (ii) The penalty charge shall be £60, discounted to £30 if paid within 14 days and £90 if unpaid after 56 days, as amended from time to time.
- (iii) A penalty charge notice shall be attached to the vehicle, or handed to the owner or person who appears to be in charge of the vehicle, incurring the penalty charge.
- 4. Where a penalty charge notice has been attached to a vehicle in accordance with Article 5 (iii) hereof, no person, other than the owner or person who appears to be in charge of the vehicle or a person duly authorised by the Council, shall remove the penalty charge notice from the vehicle unless authorised to do so by the owner or person who appears to be in charge of the vehicle. Any person who removes a penalty charge notice without the proper authority shall be guilty of an offence in terms of Section 66(6) of the Road Traffic Act 1991 as amended.

5. If a penalty charge notice has been issued in accordance with Article 5 hereof, a parking attendant may remove the vehicle, or cause the vehicle to be removed. If it is removed the Council shall provide for the safe custody of the vehicle.

#### Power to dispose of abandoned vehicles

6. Subject to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the Council may, as respects a vehicle which has been removed in pursuance with Article 7 hereof, sell or otherwise dispose of the vehicle if it appears to have been abandoned, provided they have made reasonable enquiry to ascertain the name and address of the owner of the vehicle and to inform the owner of their intention
