

The Glasgow City Council (City Centre)

(Traffic Management) Order 2010 (Variation No 38) (Holland Street) Order 2024

Glasgow City Council proposes to consider the introduction of the above named Traffic Regulation Order in terms of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

This Order is an amendment to the Holland Street Avenue Project Traffic Regulation Order Variation No. 34.

This amendment is to facilitate the inclusion of an additional loading bay opposite the Sandman Hotel entrance on Holland Street, and for prohibiting vehicles entering the section of Holland Street between St Vincent Street and West George Street

The roads affected by these proposals are bounded by:

- Holland Street, Pitt Street, St Vincent Street, West George Street

The list of roads affected by these proposals are:

- Holland Street, West George Lane

Details of the proposals are as follows:

- One additional Loading Bay opposite the Sandman Hotel on Holland Street
- Prohibition of driving on Holland Street between St Vincent Street and West George Street between the hours of 23:00 - 04:00
