Variation proposes to a) increase the on sale terminal hour from 12 Midnight to 1.00am Monday to Sunday; b) amend description of activities taking place outwith core hours to "The restaurant will be open from 6:00am for breakfast prior to the licensed hours. Weddings, funerals, birthdays, retirements etc may take place prior to the licensed hours. Recorded music and live performances may be played outwith the licensed hours. Televised sports will be available outwith the licensed hours in hotel rooms at any time and may be able to view within the hotel for sporting events"; c) amend children and young person's access terms and times to "Children and young persons will be allowed access to all public areas of the premises at all times when accompanied by a responsible adult. Young persons will be allowed access to all public areas of the premises until 11pm. Children will only be allowed access to the bar area until 9pm, unless attending a private function, where they will be allowed access for the duration on the function. Young persons will only be allowed access to the bar area until 11pm, unless attending a private function, where they will be allowed access for the duration of the function"; d) amend the layout of the premises by including 39-43 Renfield Street to the license footprint; and e) amend the description of the premises to read "The premises is a hotel with a bar and restaurant on the first floor, a bar and restaurant area, meeting rooms and gym facilities on the second floor and 91 residential bedrooms over the 5 upper floors".

Variation proposes to a) permit conference facilities within and outwith core licensed hours; b) replace the current description at other activities to read "The premises will offer a takeaway and delivery facility which may be available prior to core hours for food, snacks and non-alcoholic beverages. Take away facility during core licensed hours for persons attending the premises and orders for take away collection and deliveries of food, alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages", c) increase the capacity of the external area from 12 persons to 30 persons and the overall capacity of the premises from 135 persons to 230 persons: d) increase the off sales capacity from 7.6m2 to 16.58m2; and e) amend the layout of the premises to create a staff only area in the basement, re-location of bars on ground floor, new outdoor area layout and to include the next door unit at 11 Nelson Mandela Square; f) change the name of the premises from Absurd Bird to Dishoom; and g) amend the access terms to allow young persons aged 16 and 17 years access to the premises without being accompanied by an adult.

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
