SCREENING DETERMINATION- GLASGOW CITY COUNCIL'S GREATER POLLOK LO-CAL DEVELOPMENT FRAMEWORK (LDF), FINAL DRAFT

This letter sets out the Council's determination under Section 8(1) of the Environmental Assessment (Scotland) Act 2005 on whether a Strategic Environmental Assessment (SEA) is required for the Council's Greater Pollok Local Development Framework (Final Draft).

SEA Screening Process

The Council prepared a summary of its views regarding whether the Greater Pollok Local Development Framework (Final Draft) is likely to have significant environmental effects applying the criteria specified in Schedule 2 of the 2005 Act and in accordance with Sections 8 and 9(1) of the same.

Then, in accordance with Section 9(2) of the 2005 Act, this Screening Report was sent to the following Consultation Authorities along with a copy of the Greater Pollok Local Development Framework (Final Draft) for consideration of likely environmental effects:

- Historic Environment Scotland (HES)
- Scottish Environment Protection Agency (SEPA)
- NatureScot
