Variation proposes to a) increase the commencement hour on Sunday from 12.30pm to 11.00am; b) permit conference and bar meals facilities outwith core licensed hours; c) add outdrinking facilities within and outwith core licensed hours; d) amend Children & Young Persons access terms to read, 'Accompanied children and young persons may visit the premises to use club facilities and attend functions. Children and young persons must always be supervised by an adult.'; e) allow Children access until 10.00pm or end of a function, and young persons access until 11.00pm or end of a function; f) allow Children and Young Persons access to all public parts of the premises, but they may not approach the bar counter; g) amend the layout of the premises to include fixed booth seating in the lounge, refit of male and female toilets and addition of store cupboard and other ancillary changes; h) add an external area to the back of the premises which will include the decking area, the sides of the bowling green and the area in between the bowling green and the building; and i) add an external area capacity of 100 persons with no change to overall capacity of 195 persons.

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
