THE GLASGOW CITY COUNCIL (BATTLEFIELD)(TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2008

(VARIATION No.1 – GRANGE ROAD DEVELOPMENT) ORDER 202_

Glasgow City Council proposes to consider the introduction of the above named Traffic Regulation Order in terms of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

The road affected by these proposals is generally bounded by:-Battlefield Road to the south and The Grange vehicular access road to the north The road affected by the proposals is: Grange Road

This order is being proposed in order to provide a dedicated loading/unloading facility for goods vehicles only in order to assist the recent mixed-use development on Grange Road. Convenient access for disabled badge holders will also be provided in the form of Disabled Parking Bays.

Details of the proposals are as follows :-

- · No waiting and no loading / unloading at any time
- No waiting and no loading / unloading at any time during 7am to 7pm, except goods vehicles.
- · Disabled parking places for use by disabled badge holders only
- · Removal of existing no waiting / no loading at any time, except taxis.
