**NOTICE OF ASSET TRANSFER REQUEST**

An asset transfer request has been made to Glasgow City Council under Part 5 of the Community Empowerment (Scotland) Act 2015.

The request has been made by **Possilpark People's Trust** and relates to **Possilpoint Community Centre, 130 Denmark Street, Glasgow, G22 5LQ and Red Blaes Pitch Ashfield Street.**

The request is for the **purchase** of the land/building.

The proposed use of the land/building is: **demolish the existing, ageing building, build a new state of the art community centre and family centre, and an all-weather football pitch.**
