I can see no way in which this benefits the community as a whole, rather the loss of yet another green area. I am additionally angered that the business plan mentions that only 40 local residents were involved in the consultation 'exercise'. I cannot be the only resident who only heard of these plans by accident on this, the last day to lodge objections.
