- UK LEVELLING UP AGENDA (FEBRUARY 2022 WHITE PAPER)
 - Outlines a series of UK wide missions to be achieved by 2030
 - Strategic driver for the UK Shared Prosperity Fund

THE CONTEXT - THE UK SHARED PROSPERITY FUND

- Intended replacement for EU Structural Funds in the UK
- £2.6bn total allocation between 2022/23 and 2024/25 (mixture of capital and revenue)
- 3 Priorities (Communities/Place, People/Skills and Business Support)

UK SPF IN GLASGOW CITY REGION

- 8 Local Authorities collaborating
 - Single City Region Investment Plan submitted in September 2022
 - Approval by UK Government expected November 2022

- £6m allocation (Revenue fund only)
- 2 year fund (2023/24 and 2024/25)
- Minimum project size £200,000

GCPF – ASSESSMENT CRITERIA

- Need for project;
- Strategic fit;
- Relevance to UKSPF objectives, outputs and outcomes;
- Contribution to net zero/climate change;
- Contribution to equalities;
- Innovation in service delivery;
- Ability to deliver outputs and outcomes within the fund's timescale;
- Risk management; and
- Value for money

GCPF – PROJECTED TIMELINE

- 3rd November 2022: Fund launched - application portal open
- 12th December 2022 (noon) Closing date for applications – portal closes
- December 2022/January 2023 Assessment of applications
- February 2023 Recommendation for approval presented to City Administration Committee
- April 2023 onwards Approved projects commence delivery
