I refer to the above.

The application seeks permission for the Fanzone on 11 August 2018. This relates to the fixture where Rangers are playing St Mirren. Prior to lodging some informal discussions where had with the relevant authorities to identify a fixture that was: (1) at home; and (2) involved a Cat A team. As a consequence 11 August was chosen.

Unfortunately it has recently came to light that if the Club successfully progresses to the third round of the UEFA Cup then they will have a cup tie on 8 August and therefore the fixture on Saturday 11 August will be moved to Sunday 12 August.

Given the work has gone into the occasional licence application, the client has asked if we can establish if the pending TPEL application could be amended at this stage so that it also seeks permission for a Fanzone on Sunday 12 August as well as Saturday 11 August. This is on the basis that once we have certainty as to the day of the fixture then the application will be amended accordingly. 





I refer to the undernoted email to my colleague I tried to give you a call to have a quick chat through some of the issues but understand that you are out of the office.

I met yesterday with

As I explained to Rangers will require to take their own legal advice on the event and licence application, but I can advise that for an event of this nature we normally require the application to be lodged not less than 3 months prior to the date of the event. The timescale you have indicated is very tight in terms of enabling the licensing authority to carry out the statutory consultations and to review the health and safety related documentation.

It is a condition of a temporary public entertainment licence that the licence holder has public liability insurance of £1m. However is the event is held on council owned land the indemnity is £5million.

When lodging the application you will require to submit a layout plan of the event showing the proposed layout of all the activity intended to take place. You will also require to submit an event management plan. Further information is likely to be requested from Environmental Health with regard to inflatables and any other fairground equipment, marquees etc and in relation to catering units. Building Standards may also require further information, particularly if there are any raised structures requiring section 89 certificates. They will also recommend a maximum capacity for the event. Police Scotland will also be consulted on the application, but given that this relates to football events at the stadium, I would strongly urge the club to discuss the proposals with Police Scotland directly if you have not already done so.

While I can provide some general advice on the licensing process, I would again suggest that you seek your own legal advice. I would also reiterate that, unfortunately, the timescale is now fairly unrealistic to carry out the required scrutiny of the proposals.




