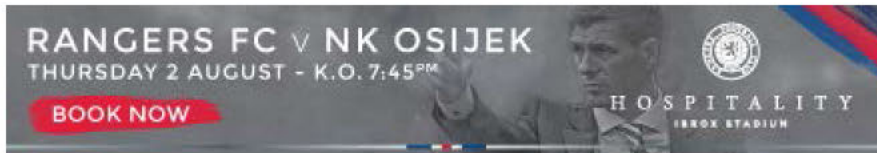
As an aside, I've not heard anything from your colleagues re: Glasgow Life presence, assuming this is down to everything being on hold?

All well I hope?

Appreciate that dialogue continues in the background but as we discussed our solicitors and myself need to prepare as if the citation and hearing scheduled for the 6<sup>th</sup> will go ahead.

With this in mind, I wondered if you could share some insight on the following?

- Who uses the pitch on matchday? Is it just the local men's football team? Any kids? If so, how easily can they be relocated?  
We have a weekly booking for Partick Thistle Juveniles on a 7-a-side pitch 9am-11am and also from Palace Park FC for a Juvenile 11-a-side pitch match 11am-1pm most Saturdays.

Those two customers/clubs would be relocated to either the Palace of Art or Drumoyne pitches whenever the Fanzone was scheduled for the pilot dates. If no availability at those two local sites, then we would look further afield into the G/Sport estate (Glasgow Green, Toryglen, Scotstoun etc) to relocate them to for those dates only. There are other sporadic users of the pitch on Saturdays but they can only book up to 7-days in advance so if the park was unavailable they would book elsewhere in G/Sport estate. Ibrox's pitch tends to be the last option for many clubs as it is the oldest pitch we own so is not regarded as acceptable for any adult competitive matches I'm told.

- **Has the pitch been used for a Fan Zone previously? (i.e. Commonwealth 7s / Scotland match)?** The pitch was used as a Fanzone for a Scottish International Match in October 2014 when Hampden was unusable due to the athletics track still being laid, Ibrox hosted Scotland v Georgia. It was before my time here but there was loads going on for the kids that day as I had friends who attended. DJ, mascots, funny photo booths, streetsoccer pro, face painting, football coaching, bouncy castles type things and football competitions for kids and grown ups.....all free of charge. There was a burger van and ice cream van too. [REDACTED] [scottishfa.co.uk](http://scottishfa.co.uk) was the SFA name on the applications & comms etc. I believe they limited capacity to 2000 and the overlay was very similar to yours as they planned the Bank of Scotland Midnight League Finals for that same day so there was football on show and also football to take part in etc. Not licensed for alcohol as there were Pubzones elsewhere around Ibrox if I remember. RFC will likely have some info on the event too I'd suspect.
- **Would you say your biggest 'custom' for the centre comes from the Club?** A significant proportion comes from RFC through their School Holiday programme in the main. There are other sporadic bookings made by RFC for weekend 11s matches (presumably for their girls or youth teams) by [REDACTED] Some of the other late afternoon RFC use of the pitch s included within the Glasgow Life's Service Level Agreement (SLA) with Education, which both Celtic and Rangers Education arms of their organisations are covered so is free of any additional charge.  
The other main stakeholder/user would be Palace Park FC who are a youth football team who train at the venue Mon & Wed evenings 6pm-8pm and play matches on Tuesday evenings 6pm-8pm. They also have requested fairly regular use of the pitch on a Saturday now too 11am-1pm.  
On Thursdays we have 3-4 adult 7-a-side groups who book regularly and on Fridays there is Community Engagement session (football, dance, badminton) every week hosted by Police Scotland. Glasgow Life and RFC used to do something similar until funding for that project came to an end I believe. The Police appear to have taken on that baton.  
Bellahouston Boxing Club will soon be relocating to our Ibrox venue in the Autumn (I may ask if they want a presence at the Fanzone to promote their club with your approval?).  
They will have a ring & punchbags up in one of the indoor spaces permanently.

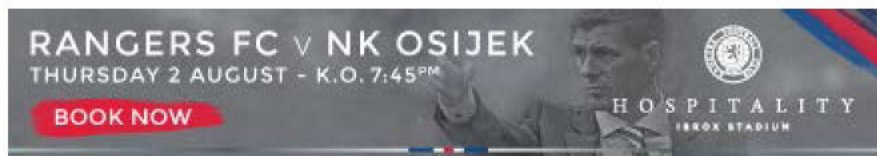
