We recently received correspondence regarding the above Entertainment License. With regards to this the Community Council would like to lodge an objection to the proposed application.

Following our recent monthly Community Council meeting on Wednesday  $20^{th}$  June 2018, our residents expressed their concerns regarding the above proposal. The main reasons for their concerns are noted below

- The venue, Ibrox Football Centre, 80 Hinshelwood Road, G51 2XP, is a community resource. Should the application be approved, essentially this resource will be taken away from the community on the dates proposed in this application. This will mean local residents, football teams and regular users of the facility will in fact not be able to use it on proposed dates. The venue itself is a community asset owned by a local community trust for use by the community.

  Should the application go forward, it will set a precedent for many more of these events to be held at this location. Essentially every time there is a home match at Rangers FC, there will be a fan zone in place, again taking this vital community resource out of the community. Since this original application has been received we have had another 3 applications PEL00735, PEL00739 and PEL00740 leading into only August 2018. If the 'Fan Zone' proposal goes ahead what affect will this have on the actual venue itself? Surely 2,000 people each match day will not be good for the pitches were the 'Fan Zone' will be located. These will certainly be damaged by this amount of proposed footfall.
- Secondly, the introduction of a 'Fan Zone' containing catering and retail units will impact the local economy.
   Many local businesses rely on the footfall of many fans travelling to games especially catering and retail

business in the area. If the 'Pan Zone' goes forward there will be similar outlets based within it, taking trade away from our local businesses. The outlets in the Fan Zone will be in direct competition with them. Adding to an already unstable and volatile industry.

• Finally, some of our residents are concerned that the 'Fan Zone' will encourage fans into the area for a longer period of time as it will be open from 11am. This puts added pressure onto the community with regards to parking, public transport, access issues and policing which are already stretched on a normal match day. Are additional measures and resources going to become available to the community due to this?

I hope that you will take the concerns of our local residents and community into serious consideration when deciding the outcome of this application. The application seeks permission for the Fanzone on 11 August 2018. This relates to the fixture where Rangers are playing St Mirren. Prior to lodging some informal discussions where had with the relevant authorities to identify a fixture that was: (1) at home; and (2) involved a Cat A team. As a consequence 11 August was chosen.

Unfortunately it has recently came to light that if the Club successfully progresses to the third round of the UEFA Cup then they will have a cup tie on 8 August and therefore the fixture on Saturday 11 August will be moved to Sunday 12 August.


