- 2. The fee payable for a Provisional Premises Licence is the fee payable for a Category 1 grant of a Premises Licence. At Confirmation of a Provisional Premises Licence the fee payable will be the balance of the fee payable as if the application had been for the grant of a Premises Licence minus the amount already paid (i.e. £200).
- 3. Annual Fee is payable each year on 1 October.

Premises Licence

1. Many Premises Licence fees payable under the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005 use a Category system that is calculated using the rateable value1 of the premises.

The following table should be used to determine the Category of the Premises.

Category	Rateable Value Band
0 ,	Premises not entered on the valuation roll or where the rateable value is nil. Also, those premises: 1. where the main function is to provide a visitor attraction and the sale of alcohol is for consumption off the premises only. 2. that are used wholly or mainly for the purposes of a club falling within the description specified in regulation 2 of the Licensing (Clubs) (Scotland) Regulations 2007; or 3. their main function is to provide accommodation, they are not open to the public other than to provide accommodation and alcohol sold on the premises is to be consumed on the premises by guests residing there.
Category 2	Between £1 and £11,500
Category 3	Between £11,501 and £35,000
Category 4	Between £35,001 and £70,000
Category 5	Between £70,001 and £140,000
Category 6	Over £140,000
